### Details of crimes reported in August 2010

#### **Other Burglary -**

Two burglaries from secure compounds within industrial estate over the bank holiday weekend. Scrap metal stolen from both.

Two separate garage breaks, two cycles stolen from one, motorbike clothing stolen from the other.

One attempt shed break. Nothing stolen due to cycles being locked up inside the shed.

#### **Theft from Motor Vehicle –**

Two linked, overnight attempt thefts from motor vehicles at adjacent properties on an industrial estate. Nothing Stolen. One vehicle was left insecure. Prevent this occurring by ensuring your vehicles are locked.

#### **Theft of Motor Vehicle –**

One theft of skip loader from industrial estate.

#### **Other Theft –**

One theft by employee – suspect arrested.

One theft from person – purse stolen from shoulder bag either at checkout in shop or in the car park when unloading the trolley. Ensure you keep you bag zipped up when shopping.

Two separate occasions of theft of lead from Upton Country House.

One theft of garden ornament from residential property.

One theft of items from a yard in the industrial estate overnight.

One theft of a mobile phone within school.

Five shoplifting offences

#### **Criminal Damage –**

One criminal damage to Upton Country House, in what could be an attempt to remove lead.

Two separate occasions whereby residential windows had the outer pane of double-glazing smashed by unknown object.

Five criminal damage to vehicles, two domestic related (suspect known), one caused by a female falling on the bonnet (suspect known). One vehicle had its wing mirror knocked off and the other had a small dent caused to the door.

**Assault –**

Two assaults linked to above criminal damage whereby suspect fell onto bonnet of vehicle. (suspect known). One non injury, one minor injury.  
Three domestic assaults.
