4. Finance

Regrettably, Alan Chilvers has resigned his position as Treasurer and Trustee. His work over the past few years is much appreciated. Andy now has all the associated paperwork and we are looking for a replacement Treasurer; the work will run in tick-over in the meantime. The balances have not moved significantly.

5. Achievement, direction and planning

We received a request for ideas for 'Community Payback' where young offenders undertake projects as part of their community service. None spring to mind immediately. Sam noted that she has had a similar request from the Prince's Trust, who are looking for ideas for projects of around two weeks duration.

John and Andy took part in a Fire Risk Assessment course run by PCVS.

In the short term we may consider knocking an extra entrance into the store room and partitioning off into two separate rooms.

6. Community Centre

We have a party booking for Sunday 14 February, and U3A are looking at extra slots. There is also a regular booking under discussion for a five-a-side group – we need to be sure that the windows in the hall are made of toughened glass and don't pose a safety risk.

It is possible that we may be able to get Steve from the Social Club to undertake the digger work behind the Centre.

We now have commitment to £93,000 for the extension, and are waiting for commitments from Garfield Weston of £58,000 and £8,000 from other sources. The Architect is now talking about an estimate of £100,000 for the build, plus whatever the fit-out costs.

A report was received from the SNT as below...

There has been a 10% reduction in anti-social in the year up to October '09, along with good indicators on crime generally. The statistics do show a recent increase in 'burglary not dwelling' but this is from a low base, and is not significant.

The next community meeting is at 6:30 on 24 February at Hillbourne, with representatives from the Police, Councillors, and Officers from Borough of Poole.

A talk is planned to 6th Form students at Poole Grammar about what life is like in the Police Force.
